Notes: (3 year trends)

Notes for Total School testing

- Live Oak -- % testing down significantly in 08 AND slight drop in scores
- Sobrato -- % testing for Cal-SOAP & non Cal-SOAP up significantly in 08, AND increase in average scores
- SB and GHS fairly flat % testing over 3 years
- GHS steady improvement in scores
- SBHS steady drop in scores (perhaps not significant)

Cal-SOAP group notes:

Anzar -- much fewer Cal-SOAP level 1 students (missing 2007 Anzar data)

In all but Anzar:

- Higher percentage of Cal-SOAP students test than non-Cal-SOAP.
- Cal-SOAP Level 1 intensive students consistently underperform non-Cal-SOAP group.

WHY? -- 2 groups of Cal-SOAP students:

- some qualify for program--at risk students
- others are students who choose to participate in a number of Cal-SOAP services -- these are students who are at least somewhat self-motivated but also realize they need additional services
