*Students in Academic Prep or who have at least 1 year with a Cal-SOAP advisor are taking the most CP classes in 10th & 11th grade

**Even in their senior year, students receiving Cal-SOAP services are outperforming their peers by 18 to 31%.

***The Academic Prep students earned the lowest ELA CST scores in 8th grade when compared using their score average
